RCHE organises 'Love My Foundation' Event

Appreciating the Rotary movement in India, Rtn Carl Wilhelm Stenhammer, former President, Rotary International and presently Chairman, Trustees of Rotary Foundation, who is on a visit to India/ Hyderabad, and came as Chief Guest for 'Love My Foundation' programme organized by Rotary International 3150, hosted by Rotary Club of Hyderabad East at Hotel Marriott, on the evening of Wednesday, 25 Aug 2010, said " Rotary International is the world's biggest funding agency working on Polio eradication which brought down the polio cases from 350000 in 125 countries in 1998 to 125 cases in 4 countries in 2010 and Rotary International is confident of making a Polio Free world by 2012. India is certainly one of the major beneficiary in Polio programme. However, India also has been steadily increasing its contribution to Rotary. In terms of increase in the number of Rotarians every year, India stands no 2 in the world and in terms of contribution to Rotary Foundation, India stands no3. We appreciate the generosity of RI Dist 3150 in Andhra Pradesh."

Rotary International Dist 3150 has pledged a generous contribution of \$500 000 towards Polio plus programme from their Annuity funds, Permanent funds and other donations from Rotarians and other donors. Dist Governor Rtn Rajya Lakshmi Vadlamani presented a symbolic cheque to Rtn Stenhammer for \$500000 pledging the donations/contributions from the District 3150.

Speaking on this Rtn Rajya Lakshmi Vadlamani, Dist Governor, RI Dist 3150 appreciated the generous donations given by several Rotarians from almost all Clubs meeting

RCHE inaugurates yet another RO Plant



RCHE is known for working on installing Reverse Osmosis (water treatment) Plants in Fluorine contaminated villages and it has already started the Rotary year 2010-11 with inaugurating one plant on 9 July 2010 at Gundrampally near Chityaal, Nalgonda dist. Now RCHE started one more plant in Gollapalli village, Jagdevpur mandal, Medak dist on 29 Aug 2010. President Madhu Babu, Chairman -WaterManagement Rtn Shiva Swamy and other Rotarians welcomed the Chief Guest Sri Narsa Reddy, MLA, Gajwal and Guest Of Honour PDG Rangayya and other guests from the village. Sri Narse Goud appreciated the services of RCHE and advised the villagers to make the RO plant work on giving pure water on one side, some income to the village on other side.

RCHE pledges to make one Fluoride free Mandal

Rtn Shiva Swamy announced that RCHE is planning to provide potable drinking water to one complete Mandal to make it free from fluoride and the chosen Mandal is Jagadevapur Mandal in Medak district which is adjacent to Bongir mandal in Nalgonda.

Rtn Shiva swamy explained that the Mandal has a population of more than 50000 and has a cluster of 30 villages (small & big) with small tandas/hamlets. RCHE has planned to install 16 RO PLANTS of (15 number of 500 litres/hour & one 1000 litres/hour) with clubbing few villages based on population and distance between villages making this project an unique one taking care water needs of one Mandal.

Shivaswamy also said that RCHE is looking for donations of Rs 40000 per RO plant and asked Rotarians to donate or look for donors from their circle. He also explained that the balance amount will be collected from villages and donation by himselh (Shivaswamy). He also suggested to look for Corporate donors for Rs 40000 donations and the plant can be dedicated in the name of donors who contribute 40k / RO Plant.
