ABOUT ROTARACT

Rotaract Clubs are sponsored by Rotary Clubs for young adults (aged 18-30) for the purpose of developing leaders and service minded citizens. The first Rotaract club in the world was chartered on 13th March 1968 in North Charlotte, North Carolina, USA. The R.I. Board encouraged Rotary club to observe the week including 13th March as World Rotaract Week. First Rotaract Club in India was chartered on 2nd April 1968 in Secunderabad, A.P. Rotaract clubs emphasizes in importance of individual responsibility as the basis of personal success and community involvement. sponsors an annual project to promote high ethical standards in one's business and professional life. Now there are over 1,64,795 members in more than 7165 Rotaract clubs in 151 counties. Rotaract also provides opportunities leading to greater international understanding and goodwill. Rotractors enjoy many social activities as well as programs to improve their community. A Rotaract club can exist only when continuously sponsored counselled by a Rotary Club.

WHAT DOES ROTARACT DO?

Rotaract gives all members a chance to work together in active service projects in community. It also links you with thousands of other who are working for better international understanding through Rotaract. Every Rotaract club works on at least three major service projects annually. Annet Pawan son of Ann Shakuntala and Rtn Rajkumar Lohiya has gone to UK to pursue MBA at Cardiff University.


Annet Sriram' son of Ann Sandya and Rtn Nageshwara Rao has gone to Texas for training as a pilot.
